

## Coachman Owners Club (COC)

COC tries to run rallies in different parts of the country, sometimes to coincide with local events, or just to have a quiet weekend to enjoy the area and company.

A Rally is a gathering of members, arranged by a club member and may last for 2 nights but can be up to 14 nights. You can book onto a rally for any length of time and will be greeted by the rally marshal. Entertainment is sometimes arranged – it may be a visit to a local attraction, a meal at a local pub, or a BBQ on the site, but there is never any pressure to join in if you don't want to or if you want to go off and do your own thing.

The site may be a farmer's field with a cold tap and Elsan point or it may be on a commercial site that provides more extensive facilities and electric hook up.

Information on rallies is in the COC annual Rally Book, which provides further details on sites, location and any local activities, programme and any other information.
